We name the Orchestra "e-Symphony" like e-Sports.

We will hold "e-Symphony" on September 27th at the EXPO 2025 OSAKA, KANSAI, JAPAN.

"e-Symphony" has four attractions.

1. Students around the world

Students from all over the world, who have various senses of values and backgrounds and who are not usually involved with each other, express "UNITY" by playing music together.

2. anyone, anywhere, anytime

Students who are unable to attend on the day of the performance can participate by video or recording, so that anyone can join "e-Symphony" and become a part of "UNITY".

3. Many kinds of instruments

Performances will be held using the new electronic musical instrument "ParoTone" developed by "eMotto", a start-up company from Osaka University, as well as various other musical instruments from around the world.

4. Anyone can join us!

By projecting images of the performers at the venue, the audience is also involved in the immersive performance. In addition, the audience can participate by clapping their hands, creating a sense of togetherness throughout the entire venue.

a-tune × SDGs

a-tune contributes to the EXPO 2025, OSAKA, KANSAI, JAPAN also known as the SDGs Expo, and the realization of the SDGs through our activities.



In order to enable anyone to interact casually through music, a-tune collaborates with "eMotto", a startup company from Osaka University, and uses "ParoTone", a new electronic musical instrument that can be played intuitively even by beginners, as one of the instruments to be played.

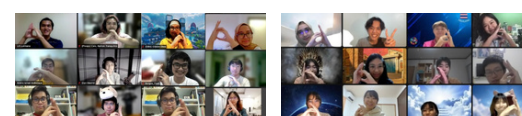
To provide equal opportunities for people to interact using music, we would like people who are not good at playing instruments or who have no experience to participate in "e-Symphony" as performers of ParoTone.

a-tune is engaged in international exchange through "music" that can overcome language differences, and one of its main activities is "e-Symphony," an online ensemble connecting with overseas students.

In December 2024, "e-Symphony for 2024 ~toGather~" was held. Connecting 5 bases in Germany, Vietnam, the Philippines, Niigata, and Osaka, we performed with 59 students from 26 countries and regions, including recordings by students who were unable to perform on the day of the event due to time differences, studies, and other reasons. On September 27th, We will hold "e-Symphony in EXPO 2025 ~Music Unites the World~" at the Festival Station in Yumeshima, the venue of the EXPO 2025 OSAKA, KANSAI, JAPAN!

We are currently engaged in holding a better "e-Symphony" with many overseas students.

International Exchange

We have online exchange events with overseas students once a month! Students from various countries such as Indonesia, Thailand, and Germany participate in the events. Through games and discussions about "UNITY", we deepen mutual understanding! We also practice music performance for "e-Symphony". (upper right photo)



The performance bases for "e-Symphony" are located in the Philippines, Vietnam, and Germany. In September 2024, we visited De La Salle University (Philippines) and Hanoi University of Technology (Vietnam) to improve the system for online connection and performance. Seven overseas students and eight Japanese students who sympathize with the "UNITY" participated in the symposium. In September 2023, we participated in the Nikkei EXPO Forum. We introduced our activities, connecting members who were in Germany online and interacted with visitors.
